Bertram Lyons works as a folklife specialist (digital assets management) with the American Folklife Center at the Library of Congress in Washington, DC. Previously he served seven years as a project manager and collections manager at the Alan Lomax Archive (Association for Cultural Equity) and two years as a media-preservation specialist at the University of Kansas libraries.

At the Alan Lomax Archive, Bert guided the shape, scope, and delivery of all the archive's major projects. He was responsible for organizing, compiling, and digitizing the archive's source materials for access via the online Alan Lomax Database, as well as disseminating these materials and their catalogs to regional archives and repositories in the Caribbean, Europe and the US. He oversaw the systematic organization of the archive's audio and image

holdings, introducing digital storage and access technologies into the archives, and supervising the assembly of comprehensive catalogs for each of these digital collections.
