Breandán Ó Nualltáin is a Projects Officer with Comhaltas Ceoltóirí Éireann, a cultural movement promoting Irish music, song, dance and language around the world. He administrates the Comhaltas Traditional Music Archive ([comhaltasarchive.ie](http://comhaltasarchive.ie)), a repository of Irish traditional music field recordings collected over the fifty-year history of the organisation.

He received an MA in Ethnomusicology from the Irish World Academy of Music and Dance at the University of Limerick, where his research focused on the intersection of copyright and traditional culture. He earned a BA in Letters, Arts and Sciences from the Pennsylvania State University, where he studied aesthetics. He has also studied composition at The Juilliard School. Breandán's professional career includes work as a Sr. Technical Architect for multinational consulting firms, and he has received professional programming certifications from Sun and Microsoft.
