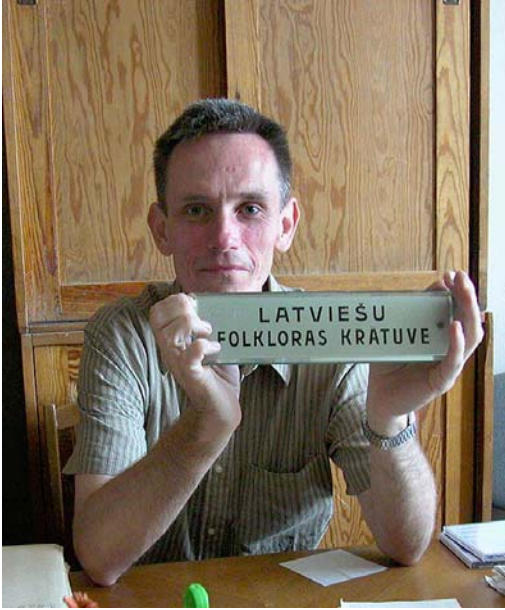


Aldis Pūtelis
