Dietrich Schüller, retired director of and now consultant to the Vienna Phonogrammarchiv, is a specialist in audiovisual preservation and restoration. He has worked as a consultant to a number of audiovisual archives worldwide, partly upon request by UNESCO. He was IASA Board member from 1975-1987, chairman of the IASA Technical Committee 1975-2001 and of the Sub-Committee on Technology for the Memory of the World-Programme of UNESCO 1994-2007. He is Bureau member of the Intergovernmental Council for the Information for All Programme of UNESCO, a member of the Audio Engineering Society, author of numerous publications on audiovisual preservation, and lecturer at several Austrian Universities. He was co-organiser of and lecturer at training workshops of EU funded project TAPE (Training for Audiovisual Preservation in Europe). He is also engaged as an organiser /lecturer in training seminars outside Europe, more recently in Mexico, the Caribbean, China, the Philippines, Singapore, Central Asia, Ethiopia, and Brasil.
